Winemaker Andrew Wenzl crafted this gorgeous Malbec from estate grapes in Oregon's Umpqua Valley. This opens with aromas of minerality, sea salt and blackberry followed by flavors of black tea and big ripe purple fruits — all supported with assertive tannins and bright acidity.

TASTING NOTES

This complex full bodied wine was assembled from our best barrels of Malbec. Aromas of blackberries, chocolate, oak and dried lavender meld with broad tannins and an earthy spice to create both tension and balance in this structured wine.
